The Award is based on: Record Book; Sheep Showing achievements; cooperation with County Agents, Fair Officials, 4-H Leaders; Showmanship abilities; overall Leadership in the Club, community, State and other 4-H work.

The application and record book must be submitted together. There is a total score of 100 points possible which will be determined as follows:

Record Book – 40 points Exhibit Achievement – 5 points Cooperation – 15 points Showmanship – 15 points Leadership – 15 points Other 4-H Work – 10 points
